Course Title: Confined Space Entry Training

Location: Client Facility or ITAC Training Center: Chester, VA

Duration: Client dependent (24 hour typical minimum)

Description: This advanced multi-media based course is designed for individuals responsible for performing, planning, or supervising work in confined spaces. This course provides a detailed look at confined space regulations, the typical hazards involved, and a variety of control measures. This course also includes a number of hands-on exercises focusing on rescue, equipment application, maintenance, inspection, and instrumentation calibration.

Content:

- Confined Space Definitions and Requirements
- Written procedure practice
- Equipment use and care
- Site Specific Considerations
- Permit-required confined spaces
- Equipment calibration
- Monitoring equipment
- Ventilation equipment
- Rescue Considerations:
 - Necessary equipment
 - Non-entry vs. entry rescue

A spiral bound course manual will be issued to each student. Upon completion of the course, students will be able to employ general confined space practices for their site and hazard-specific needs.
